The UBS solicits and researches various Bible distribution projects proposed by the national Bible societies and makes such projects available to the fellowship (including ABS) for funding. ABS signs a research and funding agreement with beneficiaries of ABS grants. This allows us to monitor and evaluate funds sent to each country. ABS researches projects before funding for project impact (life change), goal alignment, financial risk, environmental risk, managerial risks (implementer on the ground) and other possibly inherent risks. ABS receives and reviews progress reports to monitor the use of funds as a project progresses. At the end of the project, ABS or the partner conducts an assessment of results to compare with plan and budget. Information on results is relayed to management and the donor constituency. Unused funds are retrieved from the implementer and the donor's permission is obtained to redirect funds to similar projects in other countries. ABS conducts field visits to validate and document information. Some of these visits are done with participation of the major donors of these ministry projects. Our overall international program expenditure is closely monitored internally by different specially appointed groups (task forces, ad hoc groups or committees) and duly reported to our board on a quarterly basis.
