IN ADDITION TO THE WORK OF THE UCPD, UNIVERSITY CIRCLE LAUNCHED PROJECT YIELD, A COMMUNITY-DRIVEN PEDESTRIAN SAFETY INITIATIVE THAT INCLUDES ENHANCED DATA COLLECTION, INCREASED PUBLIC AWARENESS, AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS. THANKS TO THESE COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS, UNIVERSITY CIRCLE IS STATISTICALLY ONE OF SAFEST NEIGHBORHOODS IN THE CITY OF CLEVELAND.
